Sant'Anna Prosecco ~ Trieste, Italy	\$55 / \$12
Light, dry, citrus and tree fruit notes, with a slight fizz. Surprisingly vigorous but smooth on the palate.	
Mersel Leb Nat Pet Nat Gold ~ Lebanon	\$65 / \$17
These 120 year old vines are grown at high attitude at 1600m above sea level facing the Mediterranean Ocean. Merwah is an Indigenous native grape to Lebanon. To your nose, embrace notes of lychees, banana, pineapple with a delicious crispness and the perfect delicate bubble.	

## Red

Nemea ~ Nemea, Greece	\$55 / \$13
Light red colour with a rich round body. Cherry in the nose with an underlayer of pineapple and kiwi. Long finish with a taste of fruits.	
Bekaa Red ~ Bekaa Valley, Lebanon	\$65 / \$17
Cabernet Sauvignon Syrah. Hailing from Lebanon's oldest winery, founded in 1868 in the Bekaa Valley. This medium-bodied red features plum, red cherry, blackberries, and a touch of spice with cinnamon. This red wine is juicy yet smooth with easy drinking features.	
Notes Red~ Peloponnese, Greece	\$55 / \$13
Aromas of red berries with hints of mocha and vanilla. Medium- bodied with a long finish.	
Petit Couvent Red ~ Bekaa Valley, Lebanon	\$60/ \$15
Cabernet Sauvignon & Tempranillo. A natural & unfiltered red with a luscious deep dark crimson colour. Full bodied on the palate, dry, tannic with red berries, plum, cinnamon, blackcurrant, blackberry, and cherries. Long dry finish, medium acidity.

Petit Couvent Rosé ~ Bekaa Valley, Lebanon	\$60 / \$15
An early harvest rosé that offers a well-balanced & sophisticated wine. Tfeifhe is a table grape by nature and its marriage with Tempranillo offers a deep red hue and bountiful flavour.	
Roseabel Rosé ~ France	\$60 / \$15
Dry Rosé. A blend of syrah and grenache, Rosabel's expressive nose reveals ripe red fruits such as strawberry and raspberry and the palate is smooth and fresh, leaving a long and fruity aftertaste.	

## White

Ktima Voyatzis ~ Katerini, Greece	\$55 / \$13
Straw yellow colour, intense floral and fruity characters on the nose, fresh and crisp on the palate and balanced acidity. Great stylish wine with a long crisp finish.	
Petit Couvent ~ Bekaa Valley, Lebanon	\$65 / \$17
Dry, very light body and medium acidity. Featuring Obeidi, the native Lebanese indigenous grape paired with Viognier, an easy to drink staple.	
Domaine des Tourelles ~ Lebanon	\$60 / \$15
This wine seduces with exotic fruit and floral aromas on the nose which follow through on the palate, with a juicy and mouthwatering finish.
